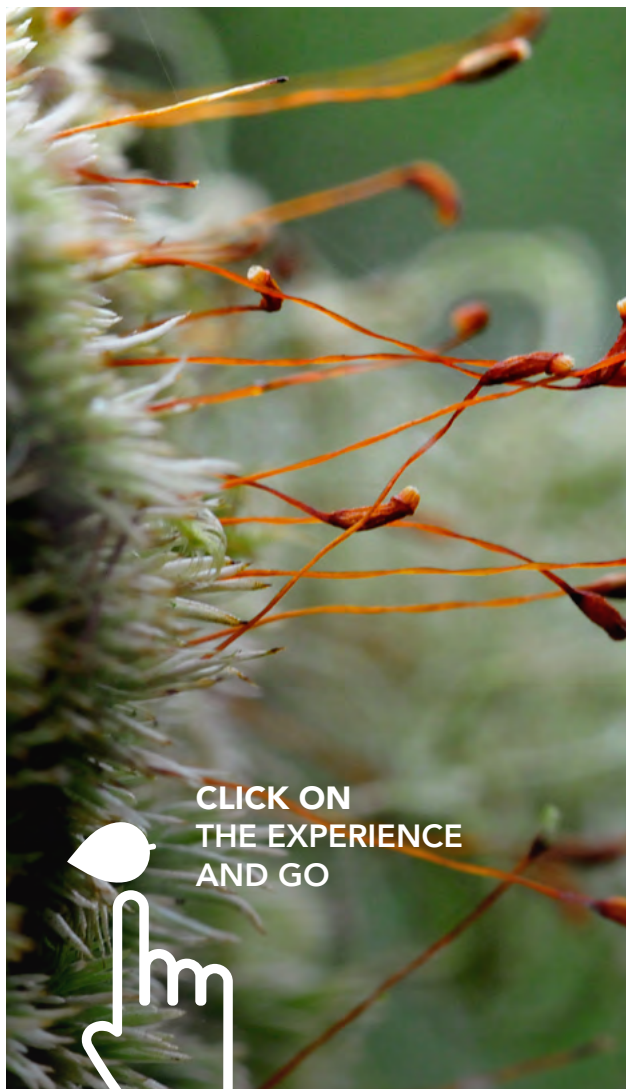

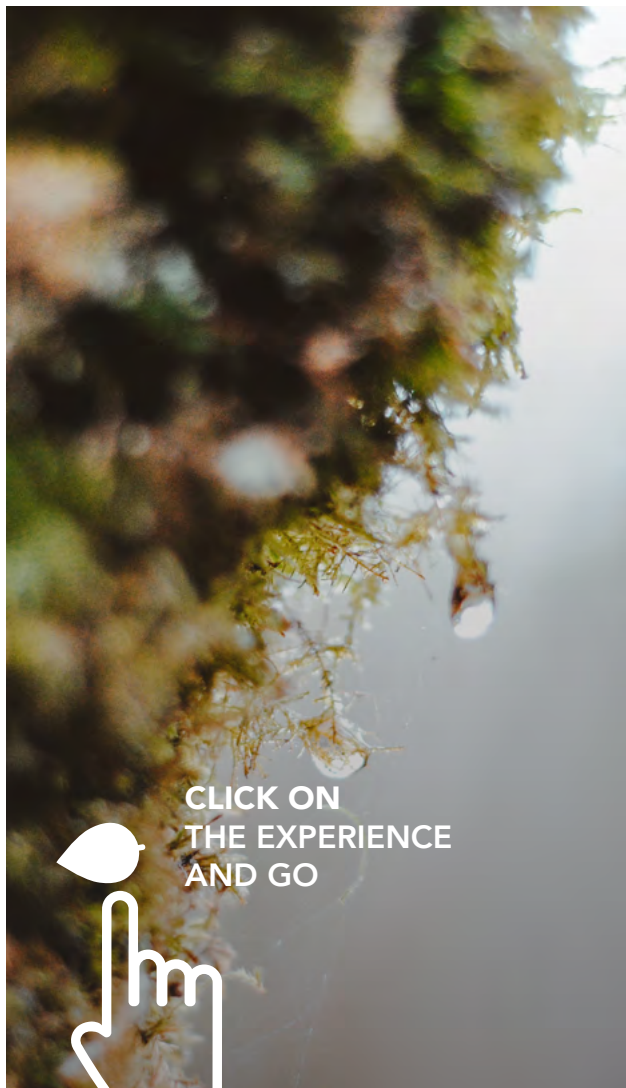

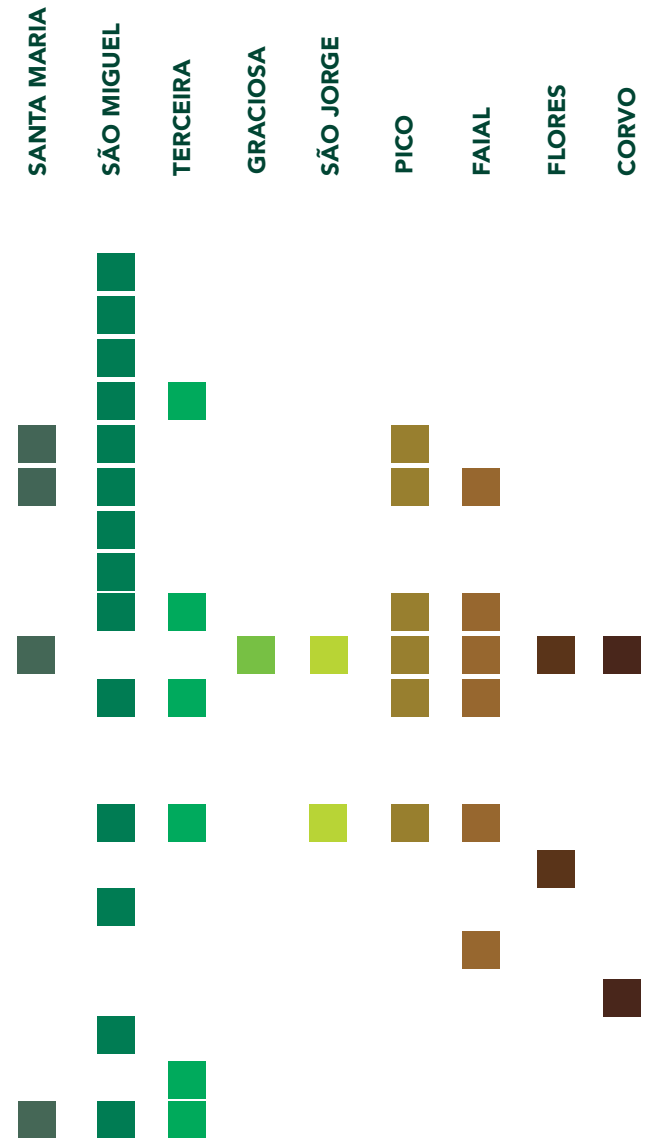

THE AZORES

The Azores, a Paradise in the deep blue of the Atlantic, call more and more the attention of travelers who are looking for meaningful experiences. Known for their welcoming and friendly people, the Azores inspire with their landscapes, gastronomy and traditions, closely connected to their nature. Stunning views, lagoons with a single beauty located in the craters of extinct volcanoes, hot water springs, peaks and caves, green fields... all this makes these islands unique in World. Each island has its own personality, charm and beauty, giving to all those who visit a very exclusive atmosphere. Every time you get to know one of the islands, you immediately feel the urge of knowing all the others.

Darwin passed by the Azores but he did not give it much credit, however, according to the scientific community he died regretting that fact. Still, he wrote to Francisco de Arruda Furtado, a young Azorean with 26 years of age (the only Portuguese person to whom he ever wrote), and he mentioned this archipelago several times, in his masterpiece "On the origin of species". With volcanic origin, placed in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean, the archipelago of the Azores is divided into three groups. The islands of Flores and Corvo make up

the Western Group, the islands of Faial, Pico, São Jorge, Graciosa and Terceira - the Central Group and the islands of São Miguel and Santa Maria - the Eastern Group.

With five gateways (São Miguel, Terceira, Faial, Pico and Santa Maria), with a two hours flight away from Lisbon and four hours from the United States, the Azores are, simultaneously, an archipelago with easy access, but also isolated, where you can rest far away from the rest of the World.

Watching the biggest animals alive on Earth, swimming with dolphins in the ocean, climbing to the highest point in Portugal, walking through natural and overlooking trails, sailing towards the sunset, surfing in volcanic sand beaches and swimming in swimming pools with thermal waters, are some of the amazing experiences which are available to all in this unique place.



SANTA MARIA

The World passes by Santa Maria, the oldest island of the Azores and, probably, the first discovered by Portuguese sailors, about 1427. It is in its airport, once a place with many stopovers of commercial aviation for fuel supply of planes like the Air France Concorde, in its route Paris-Caracas, that the control of the airspace of the North Atlantic's flight information is made.

Known as the Island of the Sun, with a drier and warmer climate than the rest of the islands of the Azores, Santa Maria has a discrete beauty. From the geological wealth of its white sandy beaches, through the vineyards that cover the landscapes, it has such a variety of colors. The green of the

pastures, the yellow of the crops, the flowers with so many colors. The white of the houses, with their particular chimneys, the red of the clay, of which tiles are made of.

An unmissable island, with a shore with so many viewpoints and cozy bays that invite to baths in the refreshing blue of the Atlantic, it is the place chosen by manta rays, has if they are complaining about the rapid disappearance of the species. At Baixa do Ambrósio it is possible to join them, in a 50 meters depth dive, and discover some of their secrets.

Welcoming as they are, people from Santa Maria affect others with their kindness and gain with their traditional gastronomy. It is impossible not to taste "alheira" with melon, "melindres", "encanelados" and "biscoitos de orelha".



AZORES





SÃO MIGUEL

The largest island of the archipelago, known as the Green Island, astonishes with its landscape characterized by a luxurious vegetation, framed in its vast meadows, in a palette with several types of green, spread along the horizon.

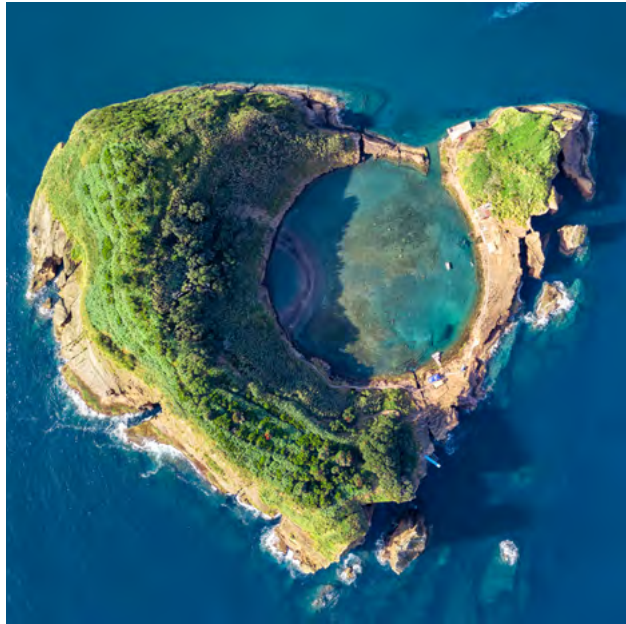
São Miguel is the stage of majestic lagoons, which are in volcanic calderas with enormous dimensions. The most emblematic ones are Lagoa do Fogo and Lagoa das Sete Cidades, classified as Natural Wonder of Portugal. In Furnas it is possible to enjoy its emblematic “Cozido das Furnas”, unusually cooked underground for 5 or 6 hours, in a vain way of using the volcanic activity present there, which is also found in hot water springs.

Its climate offers an incredible experience to most of the botanic species brought from the most exotic places in the World. In the XIX century, a set of remarkable people began a colorful and scented mission of creating the most beautiful gardens in the Atlantic, with a job that has crossed generations, to the present day, mainly through the dimensions of José do Canto Garden, António Borges Garden and Terra Nostra Park, where, among many other things, there is one of the largest collections of camellias.

The island offers a wide diversity of sensations that can be felt both on land and at sea. Walking, riding a bike or a horse, along the impressive

trails, with breathtaking landscapes, having fun in calm waters of lagoons placed in volcanic craters, canoeing, Stand Up Paddle, venture out in the sea watching whales, swimming with dolphins, diving in the deep blue Atlantic and fishing in deep-sea a delicious tuna.

In São Miguel there are great emotions for all tastes, but it is of enormous importance to have time for tea. To visit the industrial plantations of tea, unique on Europe, is a must do.

TERCEIRA

The island owes its name to the fact of having been the third island discovered by Portuguese sailors, but it is internationally mentioned for having a unique heritage. In 1983, UNESCO recognized the historical center of Angra do Heroísmo for the list of World Heritage. This is a classification that sets the importance of that city along the History of the Azores and of Portugal (it was the Capital of the Country twice). Angra had a very important role in the History of Portugal, which, together with the bravery of its people, gave it the epithet “do Heroísmo”.

For its geostrategic importance during the Second World War, the British settled a military airbase,

which was very important for the North-American Air Force, during the period of Cold War and which is still working as a platform of transatlantic convergence.

Terceira is also known for being a very festive island. The Feasts of the Holy Ghost, Sanjoaninas, Festas da Praia are some of the feasts that set the day-to-day life of people living in Terceira who, with their joy and kindness, leave a mark in all those passing by the island.

Besides the beauty of its natural landscapes, which should be visited with time, there are many activities available in this island.

Getting to the depth of Algar do Carvão and Gruta do Natal, climbing Serra do Cume and mingle with people in Angra, just walking around the city, are some incredible experiences for those visiting this island.

GRACIOSA

Graciosa is also known as the White Island, due to the predominance of trachyte (volcanic light grey rock, solid with light grades), it is the second smallest island of the archipelago and UNESCO classified it as World Biosphere Reserve.

The island is considered exceptional for diving and fishing. The bays of Santa Cruz, Folga and Praia are ideal for activities like windsurfing, rowing or sailing, which enables a strong connection with the sea.

Because of the concerns with the environmental sustainability of its people, the island is the first and only in the archipelago, so far, to be 100% powered by renewable energy. It is also due to the effort carried through, aiming the preservation

of the species, that we can find Burro da Graciosa (Graciosa's donkey), a native breed that was used in the past to help farmers and nowadays it can bring people closer to nature, considering that it is possible to ride them.

Furna do Enxofre, the islands' ex libris is a mandatory place to visit. This imposing volcanic cavity with almost 40 meters in its central part, gives access to its interior through a tower built in the beginning of the XX century, in which a spiral staircase, with 183 stairs, takes us to a cold water lake and to a fumarole with mud, responsible for the Sulphur smell which reminds us of its volcanic origin.

Termas do Carapacho are the perfect spot to relax, with thermal waters at a medium temperature of 40°, great for relaxing and therapeutic baths, in a natural and cozy environment, with ocean view and to Ilhéu de Baixo.

People must not Forget to taste Queijada da Graciosa!

SÃO JORGE

The Island, considerably narrow, is crossed by a mountain range, which makes it raised, regarding the sea, and gives an overwhelming air view. São Jorge is one of the vertexes of the called “Triangle”, name given to the group of three islands - São Jorge, Faial and Pico.

Its “fajãs”, plain surfaces by the sea, hemmed by majestic cliffs, which are not exclusive in São Jorge, but become special for being so many and so beautiful.

Like in the rest of the islands, São Jorge offers excellent means to practice water sports like diving, snorkelling, coastering, fishing and sailing. The

waves at Fajã da Caldeira do Santo Cristo, ideal for the practice of surfing and bodyboarding, fulfil the desires of the ones who love sports activities in nature. Onshore, walking trips, canyoning and speleology are some of the activities offered by this island.

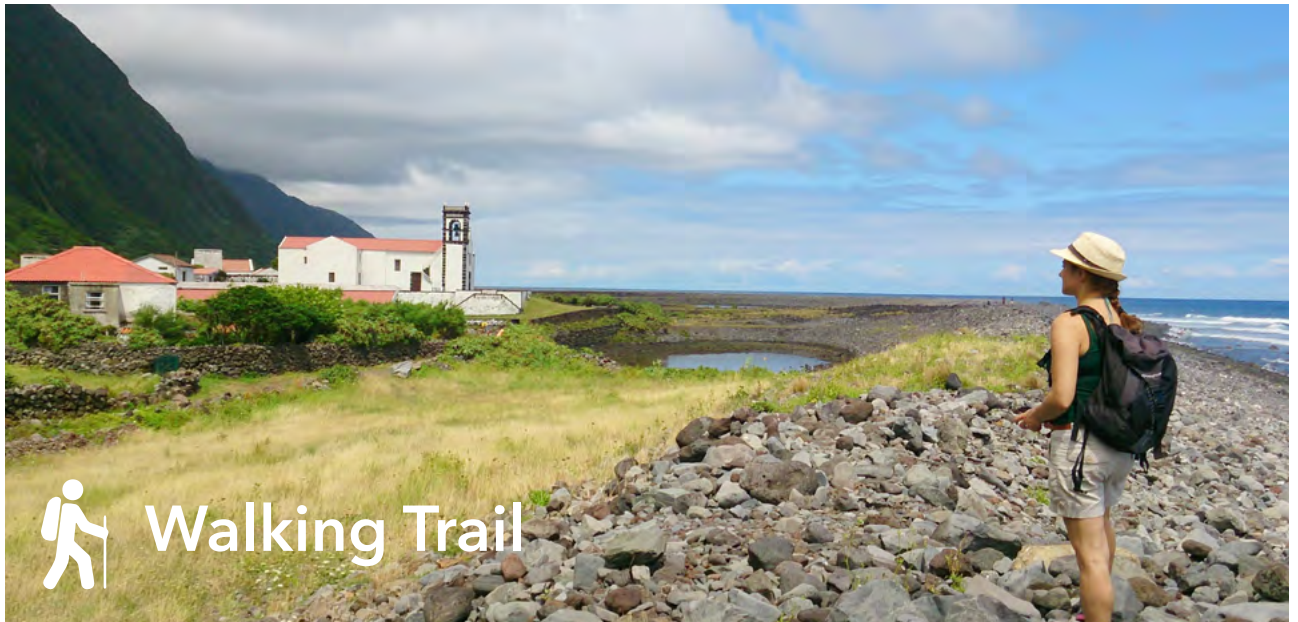
In São Jorge there is a coffee plantation which is unique in Europe. At Café Nunes, in Fajã dos Vimes, you can drink this coffee together with a Espécie which is the traditional sweet of the island.

No matter what they do, people cannot leave the island without tasting the cheese of São Jorge.

With a flavour internationally famous, it is probably the most famous product of the Azores. To taste some of them and realize the difference between cheeses, people need to know how long they matured.

PICO

The second biggest island of the Azores has the name of the volcano that gives name to it - Pico Mountain. Majestic in the middle of the Atlantic, it has 2.351 meters of altitude. Cutting the blue sky or being rolled in a protective mantle of clouds.

This is indeed the ex libris of the island and it is impossible not to be astonished by it. The most curious ones feel the immediate and unavoidable need to conquer it. The island is also one of the vertexes of the "Triangle", name given to the group of three islands - São Jorge, Faial and Pico.

In the island, besides the majestic mountain, the large fields of lava set the island's landscape and

give the support to its vinous tradition. These fields together with the vineyards give shape to the Vine Culture of Pico Island as World's Heritage of UNESCO, since 2004.

In this island, making wine is an art. As an example of its reputation are the bottles of Verdelho do Pico found in the cellars of Russian czars, in 1917, after the Bolshevik revolution. Nowadays, the island and its soil and climate conditions attract a new generation of enologists, who enjoy themselves in a very serious and professional way, producing Bacchus' nectar, appreciated by all who come and taste it in this island.

In the end of the XVIII century, the presence of whales and American whalers who came after them, made whale hunting one of the most important activities of the island, which lasted for many years and was of great importance to support population. So important that it was masterly described by Dias de Melo, Azorean, born in Pico, in his books. Currently, all the mystic involving whales is based in simply watching them in their natural environment. Whale watching in the Azores is a must. Doing it in Pico is a delicious whaling adventure.

Aligned towards the sea with its beautiful bays of Porto Pim and Horta, which integrate the Club of the Most Beautiful Bays in the World, Faial is the western vertex of the "Triangle", name given to the group of three islands - São Jorge, Faial and Pico.

The island, in its most western side, was the stage of the most impressive phenomenon that happened in the archipelago in the last hundred years. Capelinhos Volcano was the last volcanic eruption that took place in the Azores between 1957 and 1958. It transformed the landscape of the island and it increased in 2 km² its total area. The Capelinhos Volcano Interpretation Centre tells you how it happened.

The location of the Azores in the middle of the Atlantic was in several ways a gift for the world's progress and Horta, for being so central, was shelter and access to telecommunications, via submarine cables. The city had a great role in the history of intercontinental aviation. Between 1939 and 1945, the bay of Horta turned into an airport with lots of movement with the presence of the clippers from Pan America, Lufthansa, Air France and Imperial Airways (before British Airways), a very important contribution for the cosmopolitan atmosphere that one can feel in that city.

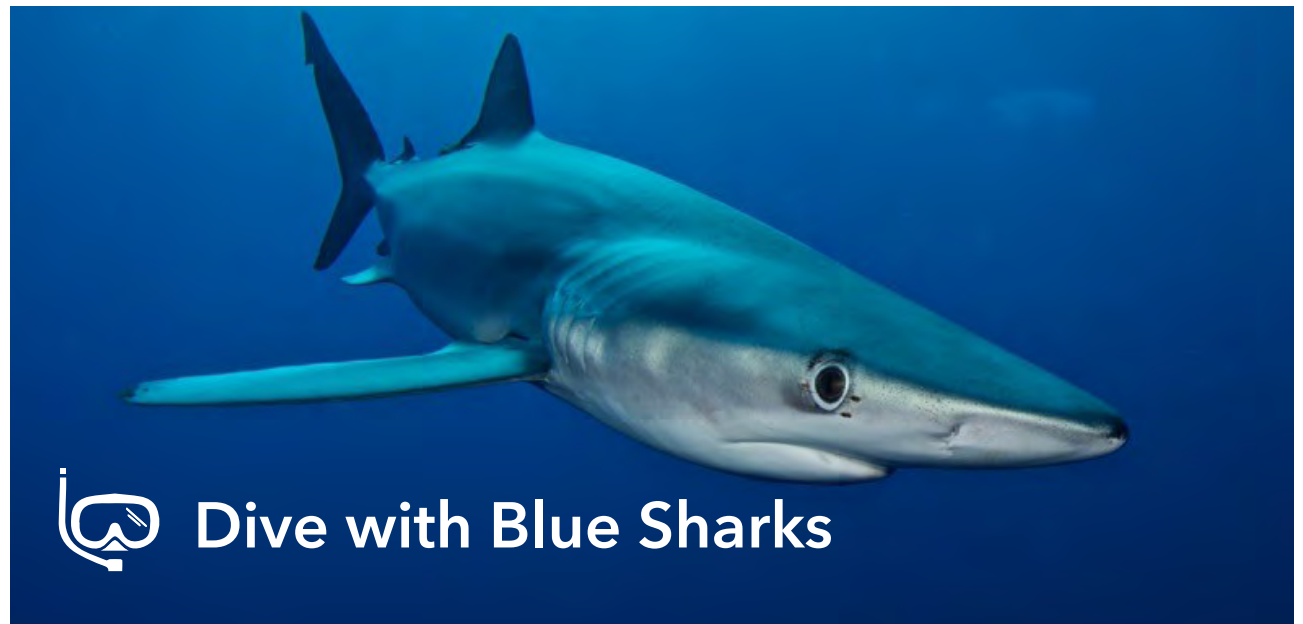
Nowadays, all kinds of sailors still arrive to Faial where the Marina of Horta is the main attraction, the so desired safe harbor! With the largest collection of nautical

paintings in the World, opened in 1986, this marina is like a modern extension of a secular importance. In 1974, Jacques Brel passed by the Marina of Horta, in a circumnavigation trip, which he never ended.

In Faial Neptune is king and José Azevedo, the owner of the emblematic Peter Café Sport, took a picture of it, in a fine stormy day. After swimming with sharks, sailing or crossing the island from coast to coast, going through one of the transversal faults of the great submarine mountain range, paying a visit to Peter Café Sport for the most famous gin and tonic, it can be the great ending for a day filled with the most pure adventure.



AZORES





The island of Flores, considered by many as the most beautiful island of the Azores and one of the most beautiful places in the World, is the most western point of the European continent. Maybe for this reason the French kept, in Santa Cruz, between 1966 and 1993, a military infrastructure aiming to track ballistic missiles, which had a great positive impact in the economy of the island and it is still missed.

A very mild temperature along the year and greater precipitation are some of the climatic differences towards the rest of the islands of the archipelago. Maybe thanks to all of this, the island has a much more luxurious vegetation and a bigger diversity

of waterfalls, established in a very idyllic scenery, to the eyes of nature lovers, like Poço da Ribeira do Ferreiro. Several water trickles, white lines in the slope of a mountain several meters high, with an exuberant and unforgettable green, with, here and there, a magnificent rainbow.

Flores was classified as a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve and it is worth every mile covered to get there. Craters, great ravines and cliffs, lakes and streams, set the landscape, favorable to meditation and getting to your inner self. In this island basalt prevails, with the shape of high plateaus, where the waterfalls can be seen among the steep rocks.

The island embraces seven volcanic craters, which turn into beautiful lagoons and provide a gorgeous view to the smallest island of the archipelago - Corvo.

Due to the abundance of streams and waterfalls, Flores offers excellent conditions for canyoning. Diving and whale watching are also activities available in Flores. Besides all this, the grandiosity and diversity of the island's coastline demand a long boat ride.



AZORES





CORVO

With only 17km² and with a population of about 400 inhabitants, Corvo is the smallest island of the Azores. It is our “volcano-island”.

Even though being isolated, Corvo surprises us with its peace and safety, breathtaking landscapes, amazing walking trails and its welcoming people. It is even more surprising when it becomes the awarded documentary “It’s on Earth, not on the Moon”, by Gonçalo Tocha, director and producer of Portuguese cinema, classified by festival Documenta Madrid as “a great film odyssey, filmed with a vertiginous rhythm with 15 chapters, which gather anthropologic records, archive pictures and personal and mythological stories”.

UNESCO Biosphere Reserve, its origin is directly related to the volcanic phenomena, which happened in the past, with a volcanic building, with a caldera on top and secondary cones.

The extinct volcano, in the North of the island, left us, what is probably the most beautiful caldera of the Azores, as a souvenir - Caldeirão. It takes almost half the island and it is considered its ex libris, with a lagoon and 12 secondary cones inside. On clear days, the landscape is absolutely overwhelming and breathtaking.

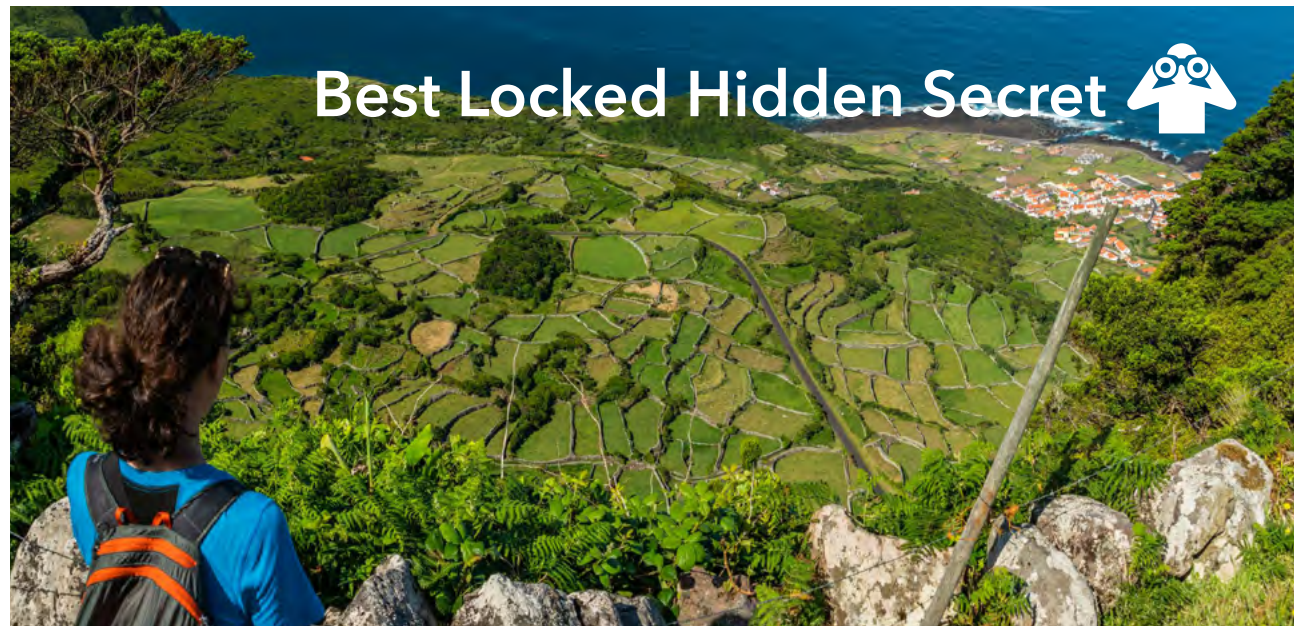
Corvo is internationally known as a good destination for bird watching, being habitat for

species like tern, cagarro and wood pigeon. Migrating birds from North America also seek food in this small spot in the middle of the ocean, while resting from a long crossing.
